



## Wilton Community Power

An important message regarding the program’s renewal, supplier, and rates

Wilton Community Power provides optional electricity rates for the supply portion of your Eversource bill. Customers that previously opted out of the program and do not want to participate are not affected by this notice.

The Town is renewing its program with its current electricity supplier, Direct Energy Services LLC, and a new consultant, ECM Power LLC. New program rates and contacts will take effect December 1, 2025.

### What This Means for You

- **No Action Needed** – Participants in Wilton Community Power will remain in your current program option (Default, Plus 10% Local Green, 50% renewable, or 100% renewable). Your selected option will continue automatically at the new rate, a slight decrease.
- **New customers** are welcome to join the program at the rates below.
- **Switch Options Anytime** – You may choose a different program option. Additional renewable energy is sourced from local and regional resources eligible for NH Class I RECs.
- **Opt Out Anytime** – Participation is voluntary, you may leave the program at no cost and return to Eversource default service. Customers that opt out of the program may rejoin the program. Customers that opt out may be charged a different (market) rate upon rejoining.
- **All changes are made on your next available meter read date** – changes may take 1-2 billing cycles to be reflected on your electricity bill.

### How Community Power Works

Participation in the program is indicated on your electricity bill from Eversource:

- The Supplier portion of your bill says Wilton Community Power if you are a participant.
- Eversource continues to send you your bill, respond to outages, and delivery power.
- Customers enrolled in the Electric Assistance Program (EAP) or budget billing will continue receiving those benefits.

### Net Metering Customers

- If you receive credits from solar panels or other net metering, you may not receive your full credits under the program. For NEM 2 customers, supply credits are zero for sales that exceed purchases.
